

## English

Use a variety of stimuli to develop descriptive writing (pictures of Tudor towns, Tudor artefacts etc)

### Report Writing

Explore reports to find information about the Tudors and then research, plan and write reports on Henry VIII's wives (or other Tudor topic)

### Recounts

Revisit features of recount texts. Explore and write diary entries of Tudor explorers as well as newspaper/TV reports of significant Tudor events.
