

Religious Education

This term in Religious Education we will be looking at the following topics:

- Beginnings
- Belonging
- Preparing

Science

Linked to our topic work on 'Yum Yum', children will be looking at food groups, healthy eating, learning about plants. We will also be looking at materials and their properties.

PE

PE is on Monday and Wednesday

Art & Design

The children will be doing observational drawing and printing with fruit and vegetables. They will also design and make a healthy sandwich, understanding where food comes from.

Music

The children will be developing their ability to use their voices expressively and creatively when singing as well as using untuned percussion instruments.

Literacy

This term we will be reading stories and poems related to food and locating information in non-fiction books. The children will sequence stories, complete story maps and will plan and write new versions of known stories. They will write recounts, instructions, and simple information sheets about food. The children will also be learning about different types of sentences, for example, statements, questions, and commands.

Numeracy

Our main objectives this term are:

- To read, write and order number to 100.
- To develop knowledge of addition and subtraction using different resources.
- To know number bonds to 10 and 20.
- To develop understanding of tens and units (place value).
- To solve simple word problems
