Science

This term we will be looking at volcanoes when we study Pompeii. We will also be studying the properties of rocks and soils.

Art and Design

We will be designing and making mosaics, making clay plaques, and sketching and painting Roman artefacts.

Literacy

This term we will be reading a range of myths, legends and fables. We will be learning to write dialogue using speech marks. We will be learning new spelling rules, e.g. adding prefixes like -un, -mis and -dis. Our non-fiction reading and writing will focus on the Romans. The children will continue to develop their inference skills using texts, photos and film clips.

ICT

The children will develop their programming skills - fixing bugs within an algorithm.

Numeracy

In numeracy this term we will be continuing our work on place value and learning Roman Numerals. We will be adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit numbers. Some of us will continue counting in 2s, 3s and 5s, whilst some of us will be working on our 4, 6 and 8 times tables. We will solve problems involving money and be able to describe properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Geography

We will be locating countries and continents on a map, looking at Roman roads and planning routes.

History

We will be learning about the spread of the Roman Empire, the invasion of Britain, Roman roads, Hadrian's Wall, the Roman army and the rebellion by Boudicca.
