Following the success of Street Dance over this past year, I am delighted to be able to offer another set of sessions which are open to Years 3 - 6. This will be delivered by qualified instructors from "Kinetic Vibes" who are well known in Bedford and come highly recommended.

We intend to run an 11-week block of sessions during this term, beginning on Thursday 20th September with the final session of the term taking place on Thursday 6th December.

The sessions will run in our New Hall and pupils will be able to sign in from 7.55am at reception. They will also be able to get changed in the classroom as they do for PE or arrive at the school in gym kit bearing in mind that they will be able to change back into uniform at 8.45am.

The cost of the sessions will be £2.50 per session meaning a cost of £27.50 for the 11 week block. This is being subsidised using the Sports Premium fund that is allocated by government to all schools in order to promote physical activity for our youngsters.
