We would like to offer pupils in Years 1 to 4 the opportunity to participate in a lunchtime "Song Squad" club. The club will be led by Lisa Collier, an internationally acclaimed performer. Lisa recently delivered an excellent taster assembly for all of the children.

Song Squad is a set of fun, lively sessions in an encouraging environment where children flourish through song, dance & performance. The children will experience a unique mix of singing, dance & drama delivered by Lisa, who is passionate about building children's confidence & creativity.
