The Vikings are coming!

Dear Parents/Carers

As many of you are already aware, we have arranged an 'Anglo Saxons and Vikings Day', which will be held in school on Monday 1st October. A Viking re-enactor from Portals to the Past is coming in to school to give a presentation about Anglo Saxon and Viking home life, chainmail making, weaponry and coin making. The cost of the day is £6.40 per child. The children will be involved in a whole day of activities and we would like them to come dressed as Vikings or Anglo Saxons! We will give you some ideas for costumes that can be put together with many things that you will have around the house - please do not go to any expense for this. A gentle reminder that if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions, then there is a danger that this activity would need to be cancelled.

Also there is an opportunity to buy Viking replica coins, if your child wishes to. There are three different kinds: - Viking Longship, Raven from the reign of King Cnut and Sword from the reign of Eric Bloodaxe. They cost £1 each or you can buy 3 for £2.50. You can pay for these in advance or bring the money on the day but it does need to be the exact cash as it is dealt with separately from the other money. This is an extra option and you do not have to buy any if you so wish.


