There will also be a class teacher PE lesson and these will commence from Wk beg 11th September. Class teachers will notify you shortly as to what day this will be.

<u>Uniform</u>

As per our end of year newsletter, a reminder that children may return to school in Summer uniform until October half-term. Please ensure children return to school in the correct uniform, particularly with regards to earrings, hair accessories and PE trainers, which should be plain black. Start of school day and Attendance/Punctuality

From September 2023, the government have placed a greater emphasis on school attendance and punctuality. Please could I remind you that the school day begins at 08.55am. All children should be in their classrooms by this time.

The school gate opens at 08.40am to allow children to prepare and settle into class, ready for learning. The gate will close each morning at 08.53am.

Children who arrive after the gate has closed will need to go via the office to ensure they are correctly registered. Parents/Carers of children (YR to Y4) must accompany their child(ren) into school office as they will need to sign their child in electronically at the office, to ensure they are marked as present. Any child not signed in will not be registered as present and an attendance follow-up will be made.

School Photographs

A reminder that the school photographer will be in school on Tuesday 12th September. This is an individual photograph and children should be wearing full school uniform. If your child has PE on this day (e.g. Year 3 & Year 4) they will need to come into school wearing uniform and bring kit in to change into.

School ArtsMark Award
