

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term we will be learning about:

## SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

**Parent Top Tip:** Explore the local environment with your child and consider the dangers to wildlife

## PSHE

Children will have the opportunity to consider their rights and responsibilities, considering their emotions within this and being inclusive



**Parent Top Tip:** Talk to your child about their emotions and how they can manage them.

## PE

This term in PE will be focussing on:

Dodgeball and outside orienteering



**Parent Top Tip:** Encourage your child to be active. Take your child cycling, swimming or for walks locally. Encourage them to take part in daily exercise or join a local sporting club.

## LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Poetry, exploring Kennings and Cinquains - Syllabic poems (Poetic form)
- Developing reading comprehension and inference
