- Advent: Visitors - Waiting for the coming of Jesus

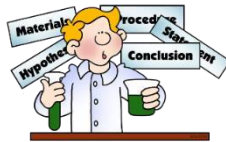


**Parent Top Tip:** Read Bible stories together as a family. Celebrate and worship together when your child brings home the SJR prayer bag.

- Online safety - The children will learn how to be safe online.

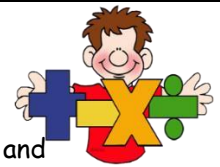


**Parent Top Tip:** Ask your child about the sites they visit online. Ensure the parental settings are age appropriate.
