

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term we will learning about:

Parent Top Tip: Read Bible stories together. Talk to your child about what is happening at Mass.



SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

- * Our 5 senses
- * The parts of our body that correlate with each sense.
- * That we can use our senses to investigate the world around us.



Parent Top Tip: Go on a sounds walk with your child. What can they hear? You could prepare a checklist beforehand

Parent Top Tip: Encourage children to share how they are feeling..

PE

This term in PE will be focussing on fitness and dance.



LITERACY

- Continuing with phonics and blending (Phases 3, 4 & 5)
- Developing comprehension skills
- Reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts
- Practising using sounds to write words, leaving finger spaces, and remembering full stops
- Learning about adjectives

Parent Top Tip: Encourage a love for reading! Read books/magazines together. Support your child in writing - shopping lists, birthday lists, cards, etc. Not every word needs to be spelled perfectly as long as they are using phonics to sound out words.

NUMERACY

Our main objectives this term are:

- Number: Place Value
- Number: Addition and subtraction
- Measure: Length and height
- Measure: Weight and volume
- Reasoning and problem solving

Parent Top Tip: Use Doodle to regularly practice different numeracy skills. Bake something with your child and get them to weigh out the ingredients.



GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about:

- What the weather is like in the UK.

Parent Top Tip: Watch weather reports together and compare this to what the weather is like in other parts of the world.

Parent Top Tip: Get creative with paint! Mix colours together to see what colour you create.



Parent Top Tip: Can you time how many exercises you can do in 30 seconds e.g. hops, star jumps.

This term will focus on mechanisms and making a moving story book. We will be learning about levers, sliders and linkages.

Parent Top Tip: Can you spot any levers or sliders on your toys or around your house?
