

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term we will learning about:

- 'Galilee to Jerusalem' which explores Jesus's good works in Luke's Gospel and how people recognised him as the Son of God.
- 'Desert to Garden' which teaches about Lent and the last week of Jesus's life.

Parent Top Tip: Read Bible stories together. Talk to your child about what is happening at Mass.



PE

- Multi-skills focusing on coordination, agility and speed.
- Outdoor Adventurous Activities focusing on map reading and orienteering.

Parent Top Tip: Encourage your child to be active, play catch or kick a ball in the garden/park/outside.



HISTORY

We will be learning about:

- * How toys have changed.
- * What did children play with in the past and how are the toys similar/ different to mine.

Parent Top Tip: Look at old photographs. Talk to your child about the toys you and their grandparents used to play with.



PSHE

We will be learning:

Created and Loved by God

- Emotional Well-being
- Life Cycles

Created to Love Others:

- Religious Understanding
- Personal Relationships with family and friends
- Life Online

Parent Top Tip: Encourage children to share how they are feeling.



LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- * Reading with understanding, accuracy and fluency.
- * Using the past and present tense correctly and noun phrases to describe.
- * Extending sentences with conjunctions (and, but, or, because, when etc)

Parent Top Tip: Encourage a love for reading! Share stories and read daily with your child. Ask your child to write as much as possible, such as: shopping lists, stories and poems.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about:

- What the weather is like in the UK.

Parent Top Tip: Watch weather reports together and compare this to what the weather is like in other parts of the world.



MUSIC

This term's Music topic is called 'Musical Me'. We explore composing our own melodies and using music notation to record our melodies.

Parent Top Tip: Practise finding the pulse of the music you listen to. Can you clap in time?



COMPUTING

This term we are learning about:

- *Online Safety
- *Programming - algorithms and debugging

Parent Top Tip: Draw a map of your home and see if you can write simple instructions to guide someone around your house.



NUMERACY

Our main objectives this term are:

- Money
- Multiplication and Division
- Length & Height
- Mass, Capacity & Temperature

Parent Top Tip: Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Play shops/go to the shops and count up the coins to pay. Cook together and weigh the ingredients.



SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

- * Our 5 senses
- * The parts of our body that correlate with each sense.
- * That we can use our senses to investigate the world around us.

Parent Top Tip: Go on a sounds walk with your child. What can they hear? You could prepare a checklist beforehand.



ART

This term will focus on developing our knowledge of colour mixing and to know how texture can be created with paint.

Parent Top Tip: Get creative with paint! Mix colours together to see what colour you create.



DT

This term will focus on mechanisms and making a moving story book. We will be learning about levers, sliders and linkages.

Parent Top Tip: Can you spot any levers or sliders on your toys or around your house?
