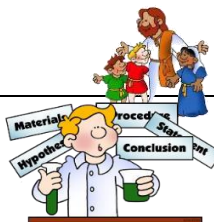


RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

SCIENCE

We will be learning about.

- **Living things: Evolution and inheritance**
Children will study patterns in humans and other species, the children learn about inherited and environmental characteristics
- **Energy: Circuits, batteries and switches**
Children will revisit electrical circuits, the children will draw conventional circuit diagrams, use models to explain current, resistance and voltage.

PSHE

The children will learn about: Dealing with emotions, peer pressure, consent, personal relationships, and the concepts of fairness, bullying, prejudice and discrimination.

Maths

Children will develop their reasoning skills further through conjectures and generalisations, justifying and proving using mathematical language. Children will apply their knowledge to solving a variety of problems.

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

History

British history: What was the impact of WWII on the people of Britain? Children will investigate the causes of WW2; learning about the Battle of Britain; investigating the impact of the Blitz and evacuation on people's lives;

Geography

Where does our energy come from? Children will be looking at renewable and non-renewable energy sources.

FRENCH

The children will learn how to describe a house, the different rooms and who lives there. They will also learn about prepositions to explain where items are arranged in their bedroom and consolidate grammar and vocabulary.

Parent Top Tip: Invite your child to describe their bedroom in French.

ART/DT

This term will focus on:

Art - Painting and Mixed Media – Creating ideas from the experiences of other Artists. Children will explore a selection of paintings through art appreciation activities.

DT: Mechanisms and Systems: Automata Toys

Children will develop a functional automata window display.
