

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



This term we will learning about:

- The story of Pentecost and how Jesus sent the Holy Spirit. How Jesus' friends spread the Good News about him and started the Early Church.
- The Parish Church is a special place.
- Saint Peter and Saint Paul were friends of Jesus.
- Learning about other worldwide faiths.

**Parent Top Tip:** To talk about the things you find in a church e.g. Altar, Baptismal Font, Tabernacle.

## Communication and language

The children will:

- Listen to, discuss and perform a range of stories, poems and rhymes.
- Explore the meaning of new vocabulary.
- Engage in small group/whole class discussions.

**Parent Top Tip:** Encourage your child to retell a story that they have heard in their own words.

## PSED

This term we will learning about:

- What a community is and how we can be responsible for the planet.
- Different jobs in the community and how work can contribute to a sense of fulfilment.
- The value of money and the difference between 'wants' and 'needs'.
- That we are all Unique and created by God.
- How to look after our bodies and which parts are private.

## LITERACY



Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Recognising all phase 3 digraphs consistently.
- Recognising all phase 3 tricky words and beginning to recognise those introduced in phase 4.
- Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound blending.
- Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.
- Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

**Parent Top Tip:** Encourage the children to recognise digraphs in the environment e.g. street signs, road names, food packets in supermarkets etc.

## MUSIC



Children come up with simple actions to well-known songs, learn how to move to a beat and express feelings and emotions through movement to music.

**Parent Top Tip:** Listen to music together and discuss how it makes you feel e.g. happy, sad etc.

## Physical development



### Fundamental ball and movement skills

Children will develop fundamental ball skills such as rolling and receiving a ball and throwing to a target. Children will be able to develop their fine and gross motor skills through a range of game play using balls.

## NUMERACY



Our main objectives this term are:

- Adding and taking away
- Sharing and grouping
- Even and odd numbers
- Doubling
- Numbers beyond 10

**Parent Top Tip:** When serving food, talk to your child about how you are sharing the ingredients equally e.g. two sausages for you, two for your sister, two for me etc.

## Understanding the World



We will:

- Learn about adventurers from the past e.g. Matthew Henson and Amelia Earhart.
- Look at how planes were different in the past.
- Learn about the moon landing and what it is like in space.
- Compare what it is like where we live to Kenya e.g. animals, landscape, homes, food.
- Learn about recycling and how to take care of our world.

**Parent Top Tip:** Talk about other parts of the world and how they are the same/different.

## Expressive arts and Design



The children will:

- Design their own superhero cape and bring their design to life.
- Collaborate to make a paper mâché moon and planets.
- Make a nature diorama.
