

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term we will be learning about

- * Pentecost
- * To put key events in the life of Jesus in chronological order.
- * How the disciples spread the Good News about Jesus and the birth of the Church.

Parent Top Tip: Read some stories from the New Testament



LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Continuing with phonics and blending sounds together to read words (Phases 3, 4 & 5)
- Developing comprehension skills
- Reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, practising using our sounds to write words, leaving finger spaces and remembering full stops.
- We will also be learning about adjectives.



Parent Top Tip: Encourage a love for reading! Read books/magazines together. Encourage your child to write as much as possible; shopping lists, birthday lists, cards etc. Not every word needs to be spelt perfectly, as long as they are using their phonics and trying to sound out.

NUMERACY

Our main objectives this term are:

- Number: Multiplication and division
- Number: Fractions
- Geometry: Position and direction
- Number: Place value (within 100)
- Measure: Money
- Measure: Time
- Reasoning and problem solving



Parent Top Tip: Use Doodle to regularly practice different numeracy skills. Encourage your child to buy something with coins in a shop. Can they add up their total?

PE

This term in PE will focus on:

- Team building games and skills.
- Fundamental skills (running, changing direction, dodging, balancing)

Parent Top Tip: Encourage your child to be active, play catch or kick a ball in the garden/park/outside



SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

- * Different types of plants
- * What a plant needs to grow.
- * The parts of a plant
- * The life cycle of a plant.

Parent Top Tip: Grow a plant together and discuss what a plant needs to grow. Spot seeds in fruit and vegetables.



HISTORY

We will be learning about:

- How explorers have changed the world.
- Sequencing events on a timeline and use this to retell a story about an explorer.

Parent Top Tip: Visit the library to find out more about famous explorers and the impact they have had on the world.

GEOGRAPHY

We will be learning about:

Human and physical features.
Features of a map.
Comparing the geography of the UK to that of China.

Parent Top Tip: Discuss local human and physical geographical with your child. Use an atlas to find the longest rivers and highest mountains in the world.

PSHE

We will be learning about -

- Caring for one another
- Living in the wider world
- Me, My Body and My Health

Parent Top Tip: Discuss how we care for one and other, and who we can ask for help.



ART & DT

This term will focus on:

- * Exploring and building confidence in colour use, culminating in creating a painted plate in the style of an artist.
- * Textiles - learning how to sew a running stitch.

Parent Top Tip: explore the use of colour in art.



COMPUTING

This term we will be exploring how to give clear instructions to a Bee-Bot and explaining how it works.

Parent Top Tip: Practise giving and following clear instructions.



MUSIC

Learning how to identify high and low notes and to compose a simple tune to represent a superhero.

Parent Top Tip: Discuss the texture of songs you listen to, how many instruments can you hear?
