In addition to emails, reminders and notices will also be sent through messaging and ClassDojo. We will also ensure links to letters and newsletters are put in the 'Parents Information' area on the school's website: stjohnrigby.org.

If you are still not signed up to ClassDojo, please contact your child's class teacher to arrange this.

Finally, we appreciate this method may not be suitable for all parents/carers and request that you contact the school office should you wish to opt-out of a paperless approach. Alternative arrangements will be made available to those who do not have access to emails.
