Year 4 trip to Cecil Higgins Museum, Bedford - Tuesday 19th November 2019

To complement our history topic, 'Anglo Saxons vs Vikings', we are planning to take the children to the Cecil Higgins Museum in Bedford on Tuesday 19th November 2019.

This aims to be an enjoyable and interactive day and will provide the children with a brilliant opportunity to explore what life was like in Bedford at various points in history. The total cost of the trip will be £4.25, which is for the two interactive workshops: Saxon Fashion and Bede's People.

We aim to leave school at 10.00am and return by 3.15pm. Children must wear school uniform, but it is advisable that they wear comfortable shoes - trainers will be acceptable.

We will be having lunch at the museum, so children will need to bring a packed lunch and non-fizzy drink. We request that packed lunches are brought in a carrier bag so that all leftover contents and rubbish can be thrown away/recycled once the children have finished. If your child is entitled to free school meals, and you would like a packed lunch provided, please indicate below.

In addition, there will be an opportunity to visit the museum shop should they wish to buy souvenirs. Any money brought will be their own responsibility.

We are hoping that this trip will be an excellent way to enhance and extend the children's knowledge and understanding of the Anglo Saxon history of our town. We ask that you return the slip below to your class teacher and pay the voluntary contribution of £4.25 online by Friday 8th November 2019.
