This term we will learning about:

SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

- Living things & their habitats
- Sound - identifying how sounds are made and how vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear



Parent Top Tip: Explore the local environment with your child and consider the dangers to wildlife

PSHE

Children will have the opportunity to consider their rights and responsibilities, considering the emotions within this and being inclusive



Parent Top Tip: Talk to your child about their emotions and how they can manage them.

PE

This term in PE will be focussing on:

- Gymnastics
- Football



Parent Top Tip: Encourage your child to be active, Take your child cycling, swimming or for walks locally. Encourage them to take part in daily exercise or join a local sporting club.

LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Narrative adventure using the Iron Man as a stimulus for writing
- Newspaper reports using the text 'The Creature'
- Poetry, exploring Kennings and Cinquains - Syllabic poems (Poetic form)
- Developing reading comprehension and inference

MUSIC

- Measurement: Length & Perimeter
- Reasoning and problem solving

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

We will be learning about:

- The Anglo Saxons & Viking
- Earthquakes & Volcanoes

This term will focus on
