SCIENCE

We will be learning about:

- Material - to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made, describing the simple physical properties and comparing materials based on their properties.



Parent Top Tip: Investigate a range of materials around the home, describing physical properties

PSHE

Children will have the opportunity to consider their being and the importance belonging within an inclusive community (Anti-bullying)



Parent Top Tip: Talk to your child about the importance of diversity and inclusion and the role they play in this

PE

This term in PE will be focussing on:

- Team games - football, rugby, basketball & hockey



Parent Top Tip: Encourage your child to be active and to take part in daily exercise or join a local sporting club.

LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Narrative and descriptive writing using *Goodnight Mr Tom* by Michelle Magorian
- Poetry, exploring Poetic form through classic poems
- Non-fiction texts to develop recount and persuasive writing
- Developing reading comprehension and inference

MUSIC

We will be learning about:
