This term in PE will be focussing on:

LITERACY

Reading & Writing will focus on:

- Text Study through Macbeth by William Shakespeare & The Explorer by Katherine Rundell
- Using different text types including descriptive Writing, non-chronological report and writing and performing poetry
- Reading Comprehension & inference skills
- Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar

MUSIC
